VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT FOR THE April 2, 2024 SPRING ELECTION & Presidential Preference

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, who has resided in the ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least 28 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued unless the elector is otherwise exempt from this requirement.

You must make a request for an absentee ballot in writing.

Contact your municipal clerk and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the primary, the election, or both. You may also submit a written request in the form of a letter. Your written request must list your name, your voter registration address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, your date of birth, and your signature. You may apply for an absentee ballot by mail or online.

Making application to receive an absentee ballot by mail

The deadline for making application to receive an absentee ballot by mail is:

5 pm on the fifth day before the election: March 28, 2024.

Note: Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

The municipal clerk will deliver voted ballots returned on or before Election Day to the counting location before the polls close on Tuesday, April 2, 2024 at 8:00PM. Any ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.
